This certification series will explore the historical foundations of service and philanthropy while providing moments for intentional, deep self-reflection. The history of volunteerism in the United States is rooted in conquest, colonization, white saviorism, and systems of control.

This series encourages participants to learn, unlearn and relearn how to confront dominant narratives of "help," name how modern volunteerism often reenacts harm, and explore liberatory models of service grounded in justice, mutual aid, and cultural truth.
